

Nouns with Pronominal Suffixes — Voweling Changes

The following table illustrates some of the more common changes in voweling that nouns go through when pronominal suffixes are appended. These are the same changes that nouns go through when a singular absolute noun becomes construct, plural, or plural construct. Note that the changes listed for each form assume that you are beginning with the singular absolute.
